My Vanzant family connection begins with William G. Vanzant and wife Catherine Baker who is on the Fayette Co AL Census in 1860 and 1870. William was born in TN about 1817 d: 1891 Prentiss MS. Per census, his father was born in NC about 1795 and his mother was born in VA about 1799. William may be the one in Lauderdale Co AL in 1840 index below. Catherine was born in AL about 1827, dtr of Obediah Baker. Their nine children were born in AL beginning with (1) Obediah W. 1844, (2) Sarah L. 1846, (3) Willy N.L. 1847, (4) James H. Oct 1849, (5) John P. 1852, ** (6) Martin Timothy b: March 1853, (7) Susan Elizabeth b: 1855, (8) George Levi b: 1860, and (9) Catherine L. 1864.

The Roster of Confederate Soldiers of Alabama shows W.G. Vanzant serving in two units: Company E, 13th Battalion Alabama Partisan Rangers, Cavalry (which was rolled into Co I, 56th Regiment Alabama Partisan Rangers) and Co H, 43rd Alabama Infantry. Wm G. Vanzant served in the Creek War and received land grants.

About 1873, William and Catherine took all their children except (1) Obediah W. and moved to Prentiss County, MS. They are on the 1880 census there but may have gone to OK or TX around 1900. I have found no graves or death records for this family yet in the NE MS area. There are no Vanzants in the book entitled Cemeteries of Prentiss Co MS by Crowe, which is a mystery since they and their children lived, married, and had children there for many years. Under this section below on MS research various marriages are recorded of this family and their offspring. The earliest one shows (2) Martin T.'s marriage in 1874 to Mary Clark who died at age 24 of pneumonia in September 1880 on the Mortality Schedule. They appear to have had one child: Alexander Grove Vanzant who married his cousin Mary E./Mollie Vanzant. Martin T. then married my gg grandmother, Martha Jane (Kiddy) Carter Oct 12, 1882 in Prentiss Co MS. Her first husband was Francis W. Carter and they were married in Lauderdale Co AL in 1872. Martha and Francis may have had a son named George Carter about 1874 (my mother remembers this) and their daughter, Mecca Dee Carter born 1877, later married Walter P. Curtis in Booneville, MS with the written permission of M.T. Vanzant (I have the certificate--these are my great grandparents). (2)

Martin T. and Martha Vanzant had at least eight children in Prentiss MS:

(2a) Melton "Stanley" Jul 1883,

(2b) Jimalee C. Mar 1885,

(2c) Henry L. Apr 1887,

(2d) Wesley L. Apr 1889 who married Mrs. Dicie Williams 1888 who already had a son named Roburn Joseph Williams. Their four daughters are: Mickey (f) 1910, Bessie 1913, Eade? (f) 1917, Oma (f) 1919, source: 1920 Prentiss Co MS census.

(2e) John M. July 1891 and wife Rosie had at least three children: Edna 1915, Alice 1917, and Jesse (male) 1920.

(2f) Joel M. May 1893 who married Dink/Mary Mize bk 14 p 105 in Prentiss MS, children: William S. 1906, Melton S. 1907, and Dicie 1908.

(2g) Lula Lucy Dovey/Lucy Ann b: June 11, 1896 Prentiss MS died Tranquility, CA June 10 1957 who married (1)abt 1912 James Owens in record bk 2, pg 568 Prentiss MS. Lula Vanzant married (1) 1915 in Prentiss Co, MS John William Carpenter b: 1893, source: Mormon Ancestral file submitted by Mabel Carpenter Reno about 1960s to Idaho Falls Temple. (I have a copy)

(2h) Timothy D. Sep 1897.

A cousin named Logan Vanzant born Feb 1833? AL, was listed on the census with Martin & Martha Vanzant in 1900 Prentiss, MS census.

(3) Sarah L. Vanzant married J.W. Fundrew/John Fondren in MS about 1875. (4) Willy N.L. I have not found.

There is a good possibility that (5) James H. Vanzant married his wife Susan in Fayette Co AL before they came to MS since she was also born in AL. James and Susan had at least five children in MS: (5a) Jane? 1869, (5b) Elixia Jane Mar 1877, (5c) Samuel L. Nov 1883, (5d) James M. Jan 1885, (5e) Lucy Veronica E. May 1891. Eliza Jane Vanzant married (1) another relative of mine, William H. McCarter abt 1894, by 1900 she was living with her father as a widow with a son, William V. McCarter, age 5. I would like very much to know more about this. I believe William H. McCarter was my g grand father's brother. Willie H. and my gg grandfather, Charles A. McCarter and wife Martha J. (Stanford) McCarter disappeared before 1900, and no records or graves have been found on either. This McCarter family last appeared in Tippah Co MS Census in 1880.

(6) John P. Vanzant married Z.A. or B.A. and had at least three children per the 1910 Prentiss, MS Census pg 202: Nathaniel 1873, M.S. 1875, M.E. 1879. I believe Nathaniel married Mary Nichols, marriage bk 9, pg 460.

(7) Susan Elizabeth Vanzant married James Phillip Champion, Oct 27, 1871 in MS Vol 3, pg 386. James & Susan (Vanzant) Champion are buried in Mount Pisgah Cemetery, Prentiss Co, MS. Their daughter Emma Champion married James D. Stephenson and these are the ancestors of Victor H. Stephenson (see other Vanzant researchers below). Victor was kind enough to give me a picture of Wesley H. and wife Dicie Vanzant at Christmas 1994.

(8) George Levi Vanzant married Mary Elizabeth Stanford about 1884 vol 4, p 576, Prentiss Co, MS. She may be kin to Martha J. (Stanford) McCarter, daughter of William A. and Liddia C. (Sanders) Stanford, my ggg grandparents who were in Tippah, MS in 1880. Researcher Bill Sexton descends from this line. Moved to OK by 1900.

(9) Catherine L. Vanzant marriage James E. Hewett about 1889 in Prentiss, MS, vol. 9, pg 369.

My grandparents William Archie and Roxie Ella (Curtis) McCarter who were born, married, and had their children in Prentiss Co MS, divorced in mid-1930s. They had three children: **Mary Ernestine 1923, Rachael Christine 1925, James Columbus 1927. About 1939, Roxie McCarter moved with her three children, brother Luther Curtis and sister Addie (Curtis) & W.T. Kimberl to Pensacola, Florida, for better living conditions, weather, and job opportunities. She worked for the WPA as a seamstress during WWII. About 1945, Roxie McCarter married again to John Alexander Oerting of Pensacola, FL, who later inherited one of the oldest businesses in Pensacola, McKenzie-Oerting Marine Supply. Shortly after Roxie (Curtis) McCarter moved there, her parents, Walter P. and Mecca Dee (Carter) Curtis sold their business, Curtis Grocery, in Booneville, MS and moved to Pensacola too. They opened a store in Pensacola and my mother, Mary E. worked there as a teenager. Walter P. and Mecca Dee are buried in Pensacola. In 1942, Mary E. McCarter married my father, Amos Thomas Robinson from Kentucky, who was in the U.S. Navy stationed at Pensacola Naval Air Base. They had five children then divorced about 1966: Thomas Wayne 1944 m. Jane Cannon Caine, no children; Donna Marie 1945 m. William H. Van Hoosen, two children-- Kevin Dale, Kathrine Dianne m. James Roberts--3 children, Kimberly, Amanda Nichole, & Sara Marie; Bonita Louise 1947 m. James E. DeBroux--3 children, Suzanne, Teri, & Eugene; ** Brenda C. 1951 m. 1969 Edward Allen O'Steen, Sr.--two children Diana Jamine 1973, Edward Allen, Jr. 1976, divorced 1985, remarried 1987 to David Barfield;

and Sharon Denise 1957 m. Robert E. Rustin, 4 children-- Marina E., Sharon, Carole, and Brandi.

My uncle, James C. "Jake" McCarter married Margarite Elizabeth Edgecomb and had five children: Betty Sue 1950 m. Henry Cosmo Calabro, two children Henry and Jody; Sandra Jane 1952 m. Sullivan, divorced in 1984; Twyla Annette 1953 m. William Pate, one child Billy; Archie Leon 1955; and Debra Ann 1958 m. Morgan, one child Rachael. Jake and Margarite divorced and he later married Doris Edith Sliter Wallace. They now live in FL 1997.

Rachael McCarter married several times but never had any children; she died about 1986 in Dothan, AL where she lived with her husband, Walker Mills.
